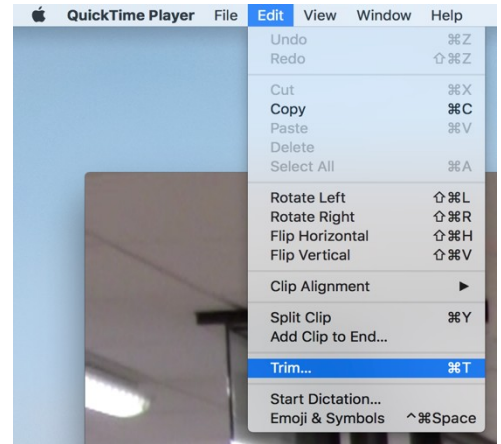


Trimming Videos with QuickTime Player

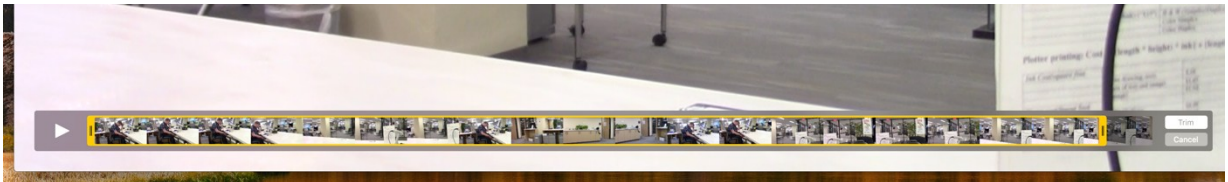
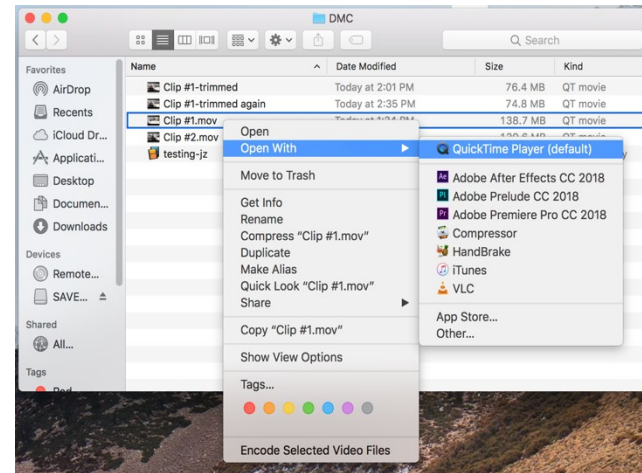
The trim feature is available on QuickTime Player X and this walkthrough is meant for that version.

1. Open your film in QuickTime Player
 - a. Right click on the file
 - b. Hover cursor over “open with...” and select QuickTime Player from the popup menu



2. You can quickly trim your video using the shortcut ⌘+T and select Edit from the top bar and select Trim towards the bottom of the list

3. A timeline of your video will appear at the bottom of the screen along with a yellow border. To trim the beginning or end of the video, drag the ends of the yellow border to the desired starting or ending point in the recording.



4. When you have done this, click the trim button at the bottom right.

5. To save the trimmed version of the video, use ⌘+S or click File on the top bar and click Save from the drop-down menu. This will save a new, trimmed version of the video.

Note: Saving files this way does not entail any transcoding so creating the new save of the video is very quick.
