ZOOM H4N: THE QUICK GUIDE

WAYS TO RECORD:

-BUILT IN MICROPHONES (STEREO)

-BUILT IN MICROPHONES + EXTERNAL MICROPHONES (4CH)

-AS AUDIO INTERFACE USING EITHER STEREO OR 4CH (RECORD DIRECTLY TO COMPUTER USING A PROGRAM SUCH AS GARAGEBAND OR AUDACITY)



To Record:

- -Press [REC] once
- -WHEN THE RED LIGHT IS FLASHING YOU WILL BE ABLE TO ADJUST RECORDING LEVEL WITHOUT ACTUALLY RECORDING
- -WHEN READY, PRESS [REC] AGAING TO BEGIN RECORDING
- -USE THE [PLAY/PAUSE] BUTTON TO PAUSE OR RESUME RECORDING
- -WHEN FINISHED, PRESS THE [STOP] RECORDING (THIS WILL FINISH AND SAVE THE RECORDING)



To Switch Between Record Modes:

- -Press the [MENU KEY]
- **-U**SE THE **[JOG DIAL]** TO SCROLL TO *MODE* (PRESS JOG DIAL TO SELECT)
 - *ADJUST THE LEVEL OF BUILT IN MICROPHONES
 AND EXTERNAL MICROPHONES SEPERATELY BY
 SELECTING [MIC] OR [1]/[2] BEFORE PRESSING
 [+] OR [-] ON THE [REC LEVEL] BUTTON



To use as audio interface:

- -PLUG USB CABLE INTO ZOOM AND COMPUTER
- -USING THE [JOG DIAL], SELECT AUDIO 1/F
- -SELECT CONNECT
- -SELECT ZOOM H4N AS THE INPUT DEVICE IN THE PREFERANCES OF YOUR AUDIO RECORDING SOFTWARE
