

VMWare Server 2.0

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Installation memo of VMWare Server 2.0.2 build-203138 on Ubuntu 9.10.

Installation script

Without this I got a compile error while running vmware-config.pl

Licensing: You can get license free by register on VMWare's web page.

- *VMWare Server (formerly VMWare GSX Server) is free, and VMWare ESX is not.*
- *VMWare Workstation is also not free.*

Boot you virtual machine from a physical disk partition.

Before VMWare Server version 2.0 (including v1.0, and GSX server), there was a option to select physical disk during the process of creating a new virtual machine. For version 2.0, the feature seems disappeared. But you can add a physical disk by adding a **passthrough SCSI Device**. To figure out which device points to which disk, you can check *dmesg* on your host.

```
dmesg |grep sg
```

I successfully boot my guest Ubuntu on my physical disk. But I failed to boot Windows XP, which gives me a blue screen after the windows logo screen. Here is a link which tell me to prepare a profile on the gust XP, but It didn't help.
