1. SCIENTIA LECTURE VIDEOS

DVDs of the Scientia lectures are typically sent to cataloging at or near the end of the semester, although they may arrive at any time. The lectures arrive identified by speaker, title, and date. The Scientia website displays a schedule useful for assigning numbers to the videos. We need to be alert to the schedule: sometimes one of the lecture videos is not delivered with the others. Ellen Butler will locate the missing video. The videos are classed together in a history of science number and subarranged by the academic year, as each academic year a different question is explored.
